To the best of our knowledge, 115 depots are individually listed on the NRHP while 64 are Contributing Resources to historic districts; thus, approximately one-third of the stations served by Amtrak are included on the NRHP.

Note

At some stations, Amtrak uses only the platform and a small shelter rather than the depot. For our purposes, such a station is counted as historic because if any work is done in the station area (platform, parking, ADA upgrades), the builder would have to take into account how that work might impact historic elements. Listing on the NRHP also affects how federal funds can be used to rehabilitate or preserve a depot since the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 directs federal agencies to consider how their actions impact historic properties. In addition to listing on the National Register, a depot may also be historically designated at state and local levels. For more information about the differences between these categories of historic designation, see <u>Protecting and Promoting Rail Stations Through Historic Designation Programs</u>.
