

## Amtrak-Served Stations Listed on the National Register of Historic Places

As part of the research for our station histories, we have noted depots that are listed on the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). A depot may be individually listed or included as a Contributing Resource in a National Register Historic District (marked **HD** in the table below). To the best of our knowledge, 115 depots are individually listed on the NRHP while 63 are Contributing Resources to historic districts; thus, approximately one-third of the stations served by Amtrak are included on the NRHP.

**Note**

At some stations, Amtrak uses only the platform and a small shelter rather than the depot. For our purposes, such a station is counted as historic because if any work is done in the station area (platform, parking, ADA upgrades), the builder would have to take into account how that work might impact historic elements. Listing on the NRHP also affects how federal funds can be used to rehabilitate or preserve a depot since the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 directs federal agencies to consider how their actions impact historic properties. In addition to listing on the National Register, a depot may also be historically designated at state and local levels.
